

### Your students can use the MyMathLab Plan to practice what they are learning

The Study Plan allows students to practice questions that are very similar to the questions in the textbook or on assignments. Students can practice, prove mastery, and continue to move forward through the material at their own pace.

#### Teachers—follow these steps to use the Study Plan.

1. Login to your MyMathLab for School account.
2. Create your MyMathLab course based on the desired book/level.
3. Once students are enrolled in your course, they will see a button in the left navigation bar for the **Study Plan**.
4. By default, a student's Study Plan is customized by their performance on:
  - a. Assigned tests
  - b. Assigned quizzes
  - c. Sample tests from Pearson
  - d. Quiz Me from the Study Plan

Note: You can modify these settings on the Study Plan Manager page (under Course Tools in the left nav bar).

5. Your students can easily access sample tests from Pearson in order to start customizing their Study Plan. You have the option of hiding those tests and assigning your own.
6. After taking an assigned or a sample test, a student's Study Plan Recommendations page will reflect any learning objectives they've mastered and show mastery points earned. Any topics that are not yet mastered are accessible from the Study Plan for further practice. Students click the **Practice** button to work on the exercises. Students click the **Quiz Me** button when they are ready to demonstrate mastery.
